If you would like to be a class rep please let your child's class teacher know, you will be the voice of the parents from the class and meet with the leadership team to discuss school improvement.

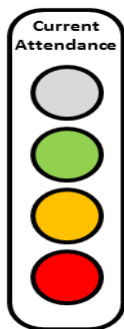
