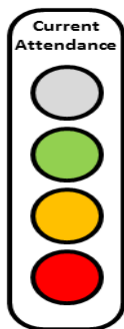
Walking around the school and talking to the children there is a feeling that children are immersed in their topic and wanting to find out more.
